

## INFORMATION ON ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

The fire and safety requirements are strictly enforced and the fire marshals do come and inspect. Please follow these guidelines:

- Extension cords need to be heavy duty (the industrial orange ones) and with three prong plugs ONLY. They cannot be plugged into each other. You need to make sure you ask for THREE WIRE as well as a THREE PRONG plug.
- The extension cords get plugged into the ground outlet (box) and any strips need to be plugged into the extension cord – not the other way around.
- Please do not put your lights up in such a way that they are touching or heating clothing, display materials, etc.
- All fabric or paper used in booth backgrounds, or on the tables must meet fire retardant guidelines. If you do not have a certificate showing this, or product that has been used to spray the fabric, it will have to be removed.
- Each booth receives a certain amount of power:

10 X 10 = 500	10 X 25 = 1250
10 X 15 = 750	10 X 30 = 1500
10 X 20 = 1000	10 X 40 = 1750

If it is determined that you are using more power than the outlet can handle, you will need to purchase more power from Edlen. The forms will be available at the front desk during set up and an Edlen employee will be on the premises on the Saturday before the show.
